



Sandbridge Technologies Acquired by Undisclosed Public Company

Sandbridge Technologies has been acquired by a large public company. The identity of the acquirer has not been disclosed, and no further details of this transaction have been made public at this time.

Sandbridge has developed chips for the next generation, multi-mode cell phone handsets based on a revolutionary multi-threaded microprocessor architecture. The company's innovations enable flexible software-based support of cellular protocols up to 4G (4th Generation), as well as all multimedia functions, without compromising battery consumption. These innovations have resulted in a strong IP portfolio with more than 50 patents granted and applied for.

The company has announced significant achievements in recent years, notably the first public demonstration of LTE (the main 4G standard), on a smart phone in 2008. The company also won several advanced development engagements with handset manufacturers and has successfully licensed its technology to several US and Asian companies.
